Some changes and the empowerment of the educational agreement between school and families are necessary in order to prevent and reduce the spread of COVID-19. We all need to demonstrate responsible behaviour, follow the new school rules as well as safety and prevention measures.

For this reason, and until the end of the health crisis declared by the Council of Ministries and the authorization of the Ministry of Health, new rules will be part of the Educational Agreement.

Families commit to:

- Check students' body temperature before school and let the student stay home **if temperature is 37.5°C or higher** or students show any flu-like symptom. Families will promptly inform their family doctors and, if necessary, Local Health Authorities;
- Make sure students follow the rules decided by the authorities and the School Principle to get into school, especially:
 - keep safety distance,
 - wear masks,
 - regularly wash hands and follow hygiene procedures
- Provide the school with correct phone numbers to make sure school staff can easily reach the family and come to school as quick as possible in case your child shows flu-like symptoms during the day. Students will be taken into an isolation room, where they will wait for their parents;
- Always adopt precautionary behaviours to avoid transmission, even outside school buildings and school time;
- Regularly check the school website and the online register for updates.

Students commit to:

- Get to school exactly at the appointed time;



- Enter school following the circulation patterns given, wearing masks and keeping social distancing;
- Reach their classroom following the circulation patterns given and keeping social distancing;
- Sit at their desks and wait until teachers authorize to remove masks;
- Wear masks anytime they stand up from their desk (i.g. to go to the bathroom) and when social distancing cannot be kept;
- Leave school following the circulation pattern given, wearing masks, keeping social distancing and paying attention to teachers' and school staff members' indications.

School staff members commit to:

- Carefully follow hygiene rules and regulations and get to work only when health conditions show no sign of Covid-19;
- Stick to current legislation on health and safety measures such as social distancing, proper hand hygiene and careful ventilation of the rooms;
- Strictly follow local health authorities' rules and regulations in cases of proven Covid-19 cases in students or adults attending the school.

Our school staff has been properly trained with respect to outbreak prevention and hygiene measures.

DISTANCE LEARNING

Distance learning will be offered in case of new COVID-19 outbreaks, as indicated by Decree nr. 39 dated 26.06.2020 - “Piano scuola 2020-2021”, section: “School plan for online teaching”: distance learning might be used in cases of new local or national outbreaks”.

Further communications will follow in case of new recommendations by the Ministeries of Health and MIUR.
